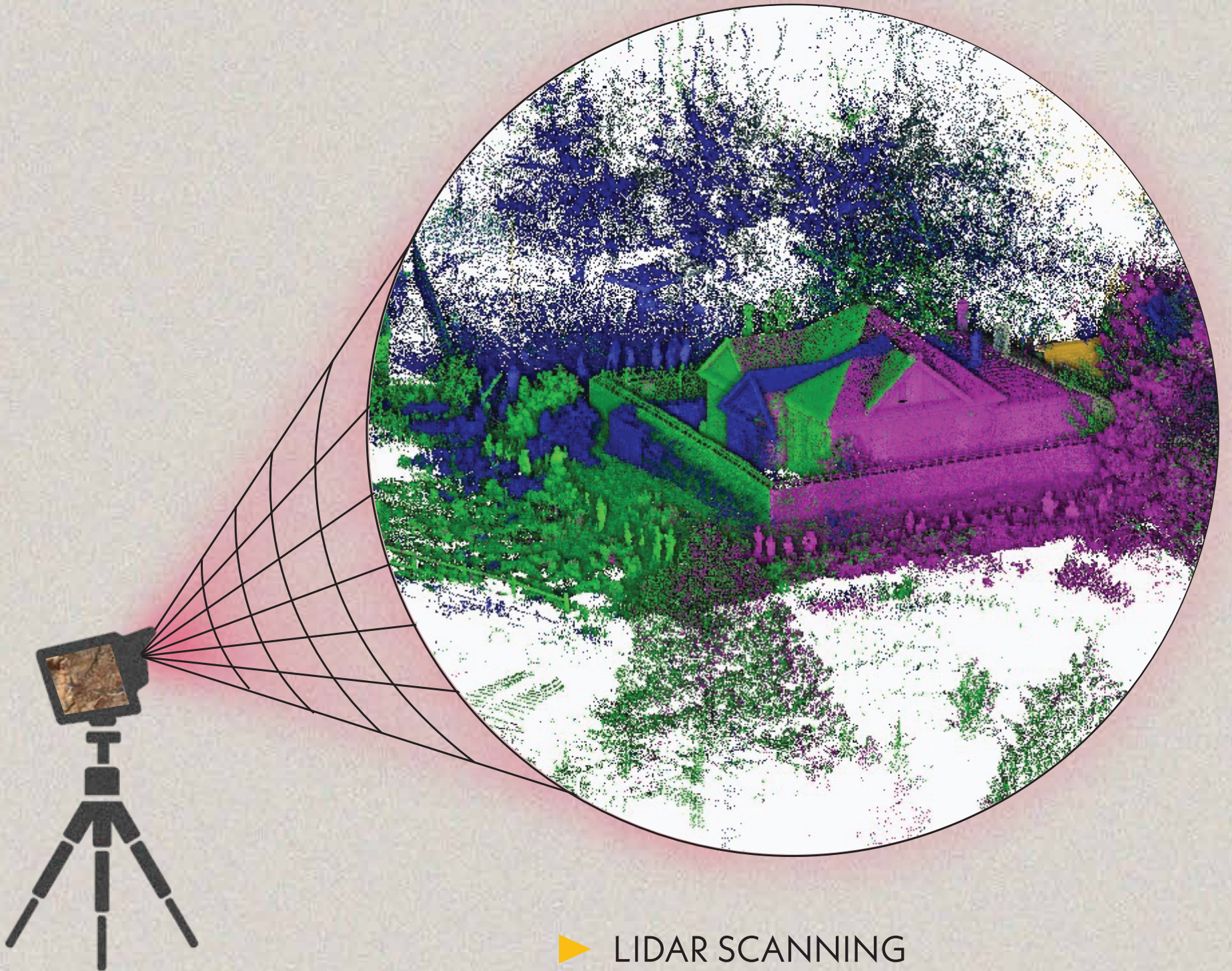

► LIDAR SCANNING

Lidar (Light Detection and Ranging) scanning technology is a remote sensing method that uses laser light to measure distances and create detailed, three-dimensional representations of surfaces. This allows historic architects and preservationists to generate incredibly detailed blueprints of historic buildings that often provide a more accurate documentation of the building and its condition than traditional methods.
